During a strike, CUPE is responsible for providing your strike pay. If you work an Essential Service shift, you will be paid by your employer. We are continuing in- person "Strike Pay Sign-Up Days" to help members register in advance for strike pay, to answer any questions you may have, and to help you be ready for a strike.

If you are unable to drop-in at these locations/times, watch for **additional dates** to be announced as well as other options to get your information to Local 204, a virtual option for Strike Pay Sign up will be announced in the coming days.
