CUPE National Sector Conference: October 3-6, 2022, the Table Officers attended the conference. I provided a report on Manitoba's bargaining and the challenges we faced here in Manitoba. Across Canada, health care workers were facing a lot of the same issues with the pandemic and bargaining. New Brunswick shared their story on how it took them years to be able to have a very successful strike. Also, they explained how they had to get members engaged and to stand with the union and bargaining committee to make the strike successful. I hope to be able to build more solidarity in our union as we are one year away from our next round of bargaining; never too soon to start.

NDP Convention: October 14-16, I was able to attend as one of CUPE Manitoba delegates to the Convention. It is always great to be around leaders who care about the working class. I spoke in support of many health care resolutions that we would like the NDP to fight for. I believe this Party that will put health care back on track. Together, we need to fight the cuts and the thought of privatization to health care.
